Town and Country Planning Act 1990

The Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport Tree Preservation (Wellington Road North) Order 2024

The Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 198 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 make the following Order—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as The Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport Tree Preservation (Wellington Road North) Order 2024.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order “the authority” means the Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council.

(2) In this Order any reference to a numbered section is a reference to the section so numbered in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and any reference to a numbered regulation is a reference to the regulation so numbered in the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation) (England) Regulations 2012.

Effect

3. (1) Subject to article 4, this Order takes effect provisionally on the date on which it is made.

(2) Without prejudice to subsection (7) of section 198 (power to make tree preservation orders) or subsection (1) of section 200 (tree preservation orders: Forestry Commissioners) and, subject to the exceptions in regulation 14, no person shall—

(a) cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage, or wilfully destroy; or

(b) cause or permit the cutting down, topping, lopping, wilful damage or wilful destruction of,

any tree specified in the Schedule to this Order except with the written consent of the authority in accordance with regulations 16 and 17, or of the Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 23, and, where such consent is given subject to conditions, in accordance with those conditions.

Application to trees to be planted pursuant to a condition

4. In relation to any tree identified in the first column of the Schedule by the letter "T", being a tree to be planted pursuant to a condition imposed under paragraph (a) of section 197 (planning permission to include appropriate provision for preservation and planting of trees), this Order takes effect as from the time when the tree is planted.

T1	Lime	Located within the rear garden of 94 Queensway, Heald Green. Situated adjacent to the southern boundary and 1m west of the garage.
T2	Holly	Standing along the front boundary of 208 3m from right boundary.
T3	Holly	Standing along the front boundary of 208 6m from right boundary.
T4	Holly	Standing along the front boundary of 208 4m from left boundary.
T5	Lime	Standing within the side garden of 210 along the right boundary and 8m from the right front corner of the building.
T6	Birch	Standing within the front garden of 216 along the front boundary and 4m from the right side boundary.
T7	Larch	Standing in the front right-hand corner of the garden of 218.
T8	Sycamore	Standing to the right hand corner of the front garden of the Church.

T9	Lime	Standing along the left side boundary 10m from the left front corner of the church building.
T10	Lime	Standing along the left boundary of the Church 6m from the left corner of the front boundary.
T11	Sycamore	Standing along the front boundary of 205 4m from right side boundary.
T12	Thorn	Standing along the Wellington Road boundary of Warwick Court 1m from left side boundary.
T13	Sycamore	Standing along the Wellington Road boundary of Warwick Court 8 m from left side boundary.
T14	Lime	Standing along the Wellington Road boundary of Warwick Court 11 m from left side boundary.
T15	Sycamore	Standing along the Wellington Road boundary of Warwick Court, to the east of T16.
T16	Sycamore	Standing along the Wellington Road boundary of Warwick Court in the front right hand corner.
T17	Sycamore	Standing along the Warwick Road boundary of Warwick Court 6m from the Wellington Road boundary.
