

Town and Country Planning Act 1990

The Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport Tree Preservation (School Mews, Bramhall Lane South) Order 2019

The Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 198 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 make the following Order—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as The Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport Tree Preservation (School Mews, Bramhall Lane South) Order 2019

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order “the authority” means the Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council.

(2) In this Order any reference to a numbered section is a reference to the section so numbered in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and any reference to a numbered regulation is a reference to the regulation so numbered in the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation)(England) Regulations 2012.

Effect

3. (1) Subject to article 4, this Order takes effect provisionally on the date on which it is made.

(2) Without prejudice to subsection (7) of section 198 (power to make tree preservation orders) or subsection (1) of section 200 (tree preservation orders: Forestry Commissioners) and, subject to the exceptions in regulation 14, no person shall—

(a) cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage, or wilfully destroy; or

(b) cause or permit the cutting down, topping, lopping, wilful damage or wilful destruction of,

any tree specified in the Schedule to this Order except with the written consent of the authority in accordance with regulations 16 and 17, or of the

Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 23, and, where such consent is given subject to conditions, in accordance with those conditions.

Application to trees to be planted pursuant to a condition

4. In relation to any tree identified in the first column of the Schedule by the letter "C", being a tree to be planted pursuant to a condition imposed under paragraph (a) of section 197 (planning permission to include appropriate provision for preservation and planting of trees), this Order takes effect as from the time when the tree is planted.

T1	Oak	Standing along roadside boundary of 5 School Mews and 14m from property
T2	Holly	Standing along roadside boundary of 7 School Mews and 14m from property
T3	Ash	Standing along roadside boundary of 7 School Mews and 5m from right boundary
T4	Oak	Standing along roadside boundary of 3 Pownall Place and 6m from property
T5	Birch	standing to the front roadside boundary of 140 Bramhall Lane South and 5m from property
T6	Cherry	standing along the front roadside boundary of 120 Bramhall Lane South and 5m from property
T7	Conifer	Standing to the right corner of front garden of 114 Bramhall Lane South and 5m from building
T8	Laburnum	standing 2m from left front boundary of 108 Bramhall Lane South and 5m from building
T9	Conifer	standing along roadside front boundary of 106 Bramhall Lane South and 1m from left boundary
T10	Purple leaf plum	standing along front roadside boundary of 106 Bramhall Lane South and 6m from left boundary
