

Town and Country Planning Act 1990

The Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport Tree Preservation (St Elizabeth's Church and School) Order 2019

The Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 198 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 make the following Order—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as The Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport Tree Preservation (st Elizabeth's Church and School) Order 2019

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order "the authority" means the Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council.

(2) In this Order any reference to a numbered section is a reference to the section so numbered in the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and any reference to a numbered regulation is a reference to the regulation so numbered in the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation)(England) Regulations 2012.

Effect

3. (1) Subject to article 4, this Order takes effect provisionally on the date on which it is made.

(2) Without prejudice to subsection (7) of section 198 (power to make tree preservation orders) or subsection (1) of section 200 (tree preservation orders: Forestry Commissioners) and, subject to the exceptions in regulation 14, no person shall—

(a) cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage, or wilfully destroy; or

(b) cause or permit the cutting down, topping, lopping, wilful damage or wilful destruction of,

any tree specified in the Schedule to this Order except with the written consent of the authority in accordance with regulations 16 and 17, or of the

Secretary of State in accordance with regulation 23, and, where such consent is given subject to conditions, in accordance with those conditions.

Application to trees to be planted pursuant to a condition

4. In relation to any tree identified in the first column of the Schedule by the letter "C", being a tree to be planted pursuant to a condition imposed under paragraph (a) of section 197 (planning permission to include appropriate provision for preservation and planting of trees), this Order takes effect as from the time when the tree is planted.

T4	Hornbeam	Standing 1m west of Bedford street Boundary and 2m north of pedestrian gate
T5	Hornbeam	Standing within car park 1m west of Bedford street boundary and 9m north of pedestrian gate
T6	Hornbeam	Standing north of the school playground and south of staff car park
T7	Hornbeam	Standing north of the school playground and south of staff car park
T8	Ash	Standing within school grounds in North west corner of David street And St Elizabeth's way boundary
T9	Ash	Standing 8m west of School building along the St Elizabeth's way boundary
T10	Ash	Standing 8m south of school pedestrian entrance along St Elizabeth's way boundary and 8m north of southern boundary
T11	Ash	Standing within school grounds at the junction of the Southern boundary and the St Elizabeth's way boundary
T12	Lime	Standing within the Nursery school grounds at the junction of the Northern Boundary and St Elizabeth's way boundary
T13	Lime	Standing along the St Elizabeth's way boundary 6m south of nursery school southern gate
T14	Sycamore	Standing along the St Elizabeth's way boundary 2m North of the nursery school southern entrance

T15	Lime	Standing along the St Elizabeth's way boundary and 1m North of nursery Schools Southern entrance
T16	Lime	Standing along the nursery Schools St Elizabeth's way boundary and 2m South of School entrance
T17	Sycamore	Standing along the nursery Schools St Elizabeth's way boundary and 3m South of School entrance
T18	Sycamore	Standing along the nursery Schools St Elizabeth's way boundary and 3m from the Schools southern Boundary
T19	Lime	Standing along the nursery schools southern boundary and 5m from the St Elizabeth's way boundary
T20	Sycamore	Standing along the Schools Southern boundary 10m from St Elizabeth's way boundary
T21	Sycamore	Standing along the Schools Southern boundary 18m from St Elizabeth's way boundary
T22	Chestnut	Standing along the Schools Southern boundary 24m from St Elizabeth's way boundary
